## *1.) Traveler's Assistance:*

\*provides casework services and financial assistance for people passing through the area who have become stranded e.g. car jackings, car problems, and injuries. Also includes working with vulnerable populations e.g. the elderly, mental health issues, or people traveling with children.

\*Homelessness in and of itself does not qualify someone for services and there are parameters around the financial assistance.

## *2.) Senior Ride:*

\*provides free medical transportation for elderly and disabled adults in Jefferson County 72yo and older

\*income to be verified/there is a Program Manager for the Application/Verification process

\*call in to request application and manager will email or mail the form

\*proof of income and ID will be needed to apply
